Let everyone give as his heart tells him, neither grudgingly, nor under compulsion, for God loves the man that gives cheerfully. (2 Cor. 9:7)

Quick Numbers to Keep you Up to Date

- \$133,536 has been pledged through March 17
- \$48,451.27 has been received through February 29, 2024

Stewardship means making a regular commitment of one's Time, Talent and Treasure to God and His Church.

Q: How much should I give?

A: The foundations of Christian stewardship is both from Scripture and the teachings of our Lord. You may have heard the term tithing (the word tithe literally means tenth in Hebrew), and this refers to the biblical giving goal of 10% of your household income to your local church (Lev. 27:30; Num. 18:25-28; Deut. 14:22-24; 2 Chron. 31:5-6). Yet, we also hear from our Lord Jesus Christ that true giving is when we offer sacrificially "all that we have" (Luke 21:4), "store up your treasures in heaven" (Matt. 6:20), "it is more blessed to give than to receive" (Acts 20:35), "for God loves a cheerful giver" (2 Cor. 9:7). With this in mind, you are invited to prayerfully reflect on your own household income, and make your offering based on what you receive. Consider also what you offer to Christ's Church in comparison to your monthly utility/service payments. ("Am I giving my phone more than my Church?") Use the chart to the right as a guide.



Procession of the Holy Icons Sunday of Orthodoxy, March 24



The first Sunday of Great Lent we celebrate the victory of the icons in 843 by St Theodora the Empress. That year, St Theodora ended the iconoclastic period, or the period of the removal and destruction of icons, that had been an on and off issue since 726, and this Sunday has been commemorated as the "Triumph of Orthodoxy." During this service, the faithful of all ages processed around the nave of the church holding icons of the Lord, patron saints and various feast days. As this joyful procession ended, Fr Pete read the synodikon of the 7th Ecumenical Council, which is a brief summary of all that we as Orthodox Christians believe.
