### **Heavenly Food**

As we all know, every September our Church community gears up to host one of the most beloved and popular events of San Joaquin County—our Greek Food Festival! The Greek Festival is a wonderful time where our guests enjoy, among other things, delicious Greek cuisine. As the multitudes leave satisfied and well-fed, my hope and prayer are that they will learn about our precious Orthodox Christian faith, which, fulfills and nourishes our souls. Christ Himself says, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst" (John 6:35).

The spiritual hunger and thirst the Lord is referring to is that which takes place within us—it's that internal emptiness we may feel; it can also mean the experience of confusion, feeling lost, or being in despair. Ultimately, it is only Christ, the bread of life, who can overcome our spiritual hunger.

We partake of the heavenly bread of Christ when we choose to live by our Lord's teachings. Christ Himself said, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His work" (John 4:34). When Christ did God the Father's will, He was feeding Himself spiritually. It is the same with us—we satiate and quench our spiritual hunger and thirst and thereby experience contentment and fulfillment when we strive to apply our faith to our everyday lives. The heavenly food that is Christ is offered at every Divine Liturgy. Our Lord says, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you. Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. For My flesh is food indeed, and My blood is drink indeed. He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him" (John 6:53-56). Christ is of course referring to Holy Communion and therefore is telling us we should receive His Body and Blood regularly to nourish and strengthen us.

The delicious Greek dishes that people will experience at our beautiful Festival is but a glimpse of the heavenly food which is Christ Himself and that St. Basil's Orthodox Church offers every week. God desires that all people partake of this spiritual food and drink, so that all people will "taste and see that the Lord is good" (Psalm 34:8).






